### CODE OF CONDUCT

#### ETHICAL BEHAVIOUR

- All participants are to behave in a truly ethical manner which at all times is in the best interests of all stakeholders

#### BEHAVIOUR AT RACE MEETING

- Team Drivers are responsible for their conduct as well as the conduct of any person associated with them such as pit crews, vehicle owners, and sponsors
- Avoid arguing with a official – if you disagree with a ruling, in a calm and reasoned manner check with the officials on how the decision was reached
- Control your temper – verbal and physical abuse of stewards or other competitors, and deliberately distracting or provoking others is not acceptable or permissible behaviour
- Treat all competitors as you would like to be treated – do not interfere with, bully or take advantage of any other participant
- At all times avoid the use of coarse or derogatory language

#### PREPARING TO RACE

- Driver and crew must be dressed in appropriate clothing and foot wear.
- Race car must be brought to dummy grid when called at a safe pace.
- Driver must be ready to race with seat belts tight and helmet and other safe equipment secured when advised by officials.

#### WORKING ON CARS

- Driver and crew must work on race cars in a safe manner using safe methods at all times (eg jack stands, approved fuel containers).

#### AFTER RACE HAS FINISHED

- Drivers are to follow any instructions given by officials
- Driver is to leave the race track at a safe speed and must not break traction when driving in the pit area.

#### DISCIPLINARY ACTION

- Drivers understand that non-compliance with the above code is likely to result in disciplinary action by NSSS officials.
